On January 26, 2005, Three-Five Systems, Inc. (TFS), the primary manufacturer for Microtune, Inc. s (Microtune) subsystem module products, announced that it is planning a number of actions designed to reduce operating costs and excess manufacturing capacity. Such actions include exploring the potential sale of its Manila, Philippines factory, where nearly all of Microtune s subsystem module products are manufactured. TFS and Microtune are currently working together to ensure that support and product shipments remain uninterrupted.
