Item 1.01. Entry into a Material Definitive Agreement Indemnification Agreements

On December 14, 2011, Publix Super Markets, Inc. (the Company) executed new indemnification agreements with the trustee of the Company s Employee Stock Ownership Plan (Hoyt R. Under the indemnification agreements, the Company agrees to indemnify each of these trustees and investment committee members to the fullest extent permitted by law against any and all costs, claims, losses, damages and expenses that may be incurred or suffered as related to his or her activities as a trustee or investment committee member.
