(“Casino”), its subsidiaries Segisor and Sudaco Participações Ltda. requested an arbitration proceeding (“Arbitration”) wherein CBD was included as one of the Respondents, as anticipated by the Material Fact July 4. The terms of the Arbitration are subject to confidentiality obligations.
