As such, each of the Reporting Persons could have been deemed the beneficial owner of 9.4% of Shares outstanding as of March 11, 2011 (based on 44,501,246 Shares outstanding as of March 11, 2011, comprised of the 40,501,246 Shares outstanding according to the Issuer's supplemental prospectus on Form 424B5, filed on March 11, 2011, and adding to that amount the 4,000,000 Shares acquired by the Reporting Persons on March 11, 2011, pursuant to the Offering).
