On February 6, 2008, the shareholders of the Company approved the plan of merger contained in the merger agreement dated as of October 2, 2007, among the Company, The Toronto-Dominion Bank (TD) and Cardinal Merger Co. (the Merger Agreement), pursuant to which TD will acquire the Company. Approximately 97% of the participating shares voted in favor of the merger. On February 6, 2008, the Company and TD issued a joint press release with respect to shareholder approval of the merger, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated hereby by reference as Exhibit 99.1 hereto.

The approval of the plan of merger by Commerce s shareholders satisfies one of the conditions to completion of the transaction. Consummation of the transaction remains subject to other customary closing conditions, including the receipt of regulatory approvals.
