Metropolitan Edison Company's Form 10-Q is part of a combined filing with its parent company, FirstEnergy Corp. The Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for the quarter ended June 30, 2003 could not be filed within the prescribed time period due to FirstEnergy's restatement of earnings for the year ended December 31, 2002 and the first quarter of 2003, to reflect a change in the method of amortizing costs being recovered under the Ohio transition plan and recognition of above-market values of certain leased generation facilities.

The restatements related to FirstEnergy and its Ohio subsidiaries do not affect the financial statements of Metropolitan Edison Company, only the timing of the filing of its Form 10-Q for the guarter ended June 30, 2003.

Net income in the second quarter of 2003 decreased to \$12.9 million from \$16.0 million in the second quarter of 2002. During the first six months of 2003, net income decreased to \$29.9 million from \$42.6 million in the first six months of 2002. Results in both periods were adversely affected by reduced sales margins driven by lower generation kilowatt-hour sales.
